Flourishing in the Age of AI: A One-Day Deep Dive

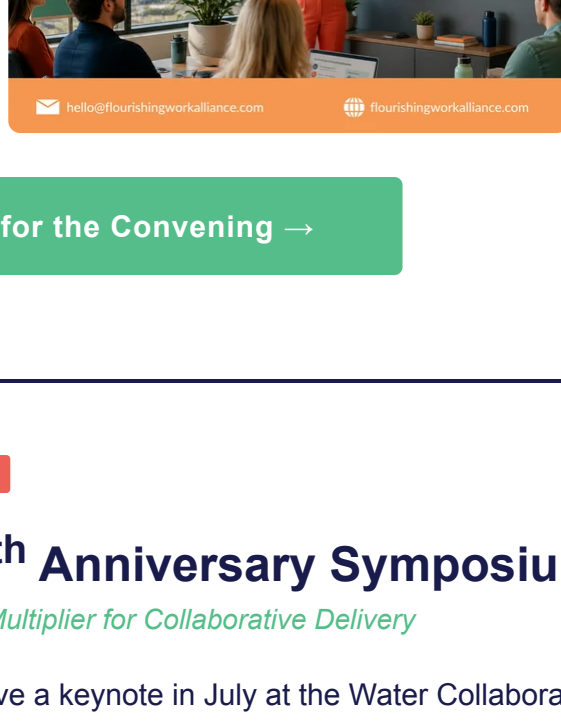
Registration is now open. AI is moving faster than most organizations' ability to adapt. On **November 12**, join us for a full day - in person in Denver or virtually.

WCDA 20th Anniversary Symposium

Flourishing As a Multiplier for Collaborative Delivery

Eleanor Allen gave a keynote in July at the Water Collaborative Delivery Association Symposium about the science behind human flourishing and how it can be used in the collaborative delivery of water infrastructure projects. After the TED-style keynote, Eleanor moderated a panel with executives **Bruce Husslebee** and **Mariana Chavez** about how they bring flourishing to life in their organizations. They shared real-life examples of how they have intentionally leaned into practical wisdom, creativity, relationships, and character & virtue to strengthen their organizations and achieve excellent performance.

Symposium attendees were also able to get their own Flourishing At Work scores before the conference using the FW Alliance's AI-enabled assessment tool. The aggregated results were shared with the audience during the keynote.

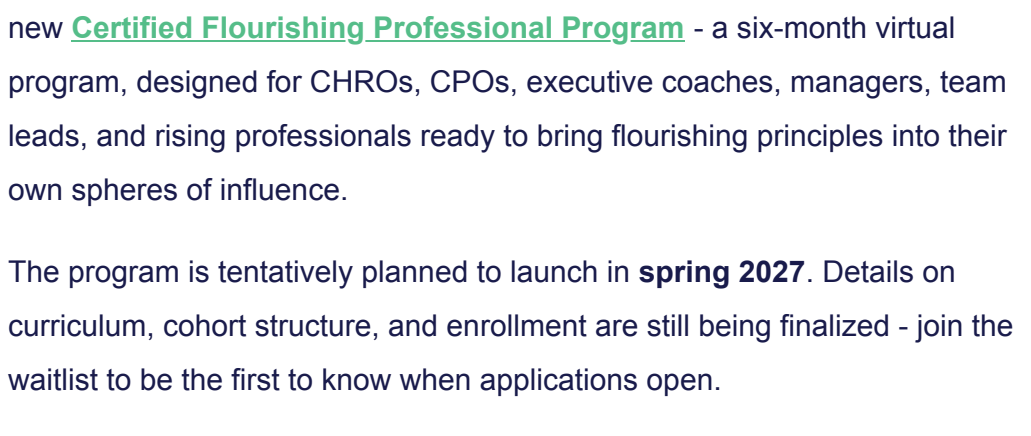
Executive Flourishing Forum

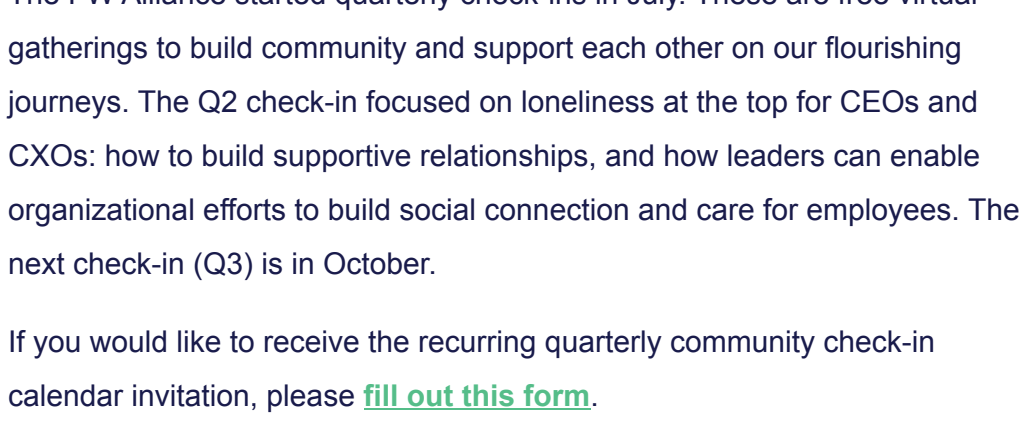

On September 9th we are launching the 2026 cohort of the **Certified Flourishing Executive Program** - a 7-month virtual program, designed for CEOs, CXOs, and board members who want to engage with leading-edge research on human flourishing developed at Baylor University and Harvard University and translate those insights into practical workplace application.
